Bringing Your Pet to Medellín

Necessary Documentation

To bring your pet to Colombia, you'll need the following documentation:

Health Certificate: A health certificate issued by a USDA-accredited veterinarian within 10 days of travel.

This certificate should indicate that your pet is in good health, free from contagious diseases, and up-to-date on vaccinations.





Rabies Vaccination Certificate: Your pet must have a rabies vaccination certificate that is valid for at least 30 days prior to travel.

Microchip: Your pet must be microchipped with an ISO-compliant microchip.

Additional Requirements

Age: Pets must be at least four months old to enter Colombia.

Travel with Owner: Your pet must travel with you in the cabin of the aircraft.

No Import Permit: Personal pets do not require an import permit to enter Colombia.

Staying Updated

The cost of apostilling a document in the USA varies depending on several factors:




